Childbirth and Infant Care Series



Our Childbirth and Infant Care classes prepare expectant couples for the physical and emotional changes that occur during pregnancy, delivery, and postpartum. These classes provide an overview of labor, teach you to care for your newborn, and help prepare you for the upcoming changes in your routine, emotions, and relationship. We recommend you register for classes mid-term in your pregnancy.

Series Details

All seven classes run from 6:30-8:30 pm except for class B in the In-Person series, which will run from 6:30-9:00 pm to include a hospital tour. You can also take classes A-C on a single Saturday.

We recommend taking the full series and offer the convenience of choosing A – G OR D – G then A – C. You also have the option to enroll in only Childbirth OR Infant Care.

COST

For the entire series (all seven Childbirth and Infant Care classes) the cost is \$290 per couple. If taken separately, the Childbirth Series (A – C) is \$140 and the Infant Care Series (D – G) is \$185. Registration is required.

LOCATION

You can choose to attend either an in-person series (Wednesdays) or a virtual series (Thursdays). In-person classes will be held in the Conference Center at MarinHealth Medical Center. For virtual classes, a Zoom link will be provided after registration. CPR Course

Topics include choking, stroke, heart attack, sudden cardiac arrest, emergency action steps, airway management, rescue breathing, chest compressions, cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), and AED use and operation.

After evaluating your knowledge and hands-on skills in accordance with Health and Safety Institute (HSI) program standards, your instructor will issue your CPR Certification Card.

\$64 per person or \$125 per couple. Includes course, assessment, and 2-year certification card.

First-aid emergencies covered include bleeding control; shock; soft-tissues injuries; bone, joint and muscle injuries; broken bones; medical emergencies; heat- and cold-related illnesses and injuries; seizures; poisoning; and more. After evaluating your knowledge and hands-on skills according to the Health and Safety Institute (HSI) program standard, your instructor will issue your First Aid Digital Certification Card.
